Congratulations to the Loreto College Coorparoo graduating Class of 2021



We congratulate the 2021 cohort for their outstanding academic achievements. 14% of students achieved an ATAR of 98.00 and above, placing them in the top 2% of the state. 28% of students received an ATAR of 95.00 and above, 41% of students received an ATAR of 90.00 and above and 7 students (5%) achieved an ATAR of 99.00 and above. These exceptional results reflect the diligence and commitment of our students.

All students in the 2021 cohort have graduated with a qualification, with 100% of graduating students achieving the Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE). Furthermore, 18% graduated with a Diploma and 20% gained a Certificate III or IV. 3 students have been offered tertiary scholarships and 7 students successfully completed a tertiary subject.
